FOR WIDE BRIM HATS LET GRAVITY PRESERVE YOUR BRIM SHAPE.

The brim of your wide brim hat is blocked to have an arc shape, dipping down in front and back. That curving brim shape is very important to the look and the appeal of my wide brim styles. No one wants a flat brim.

If you display and store your hat on a flat shelf, gravity will flatten your brim fairly quickly. I hated it when this happened with my own personal hats. So, I figured out how to make gravity work for me, instead of against me.

Simple – beautiful wood forms, flat on the bottom so they can be put on a flat surface, and arced on top in the curve I wanted my brims to have. The curve you will want your brim to have.

When you keep and display your wide brim hat on one of my Arced Brim Forms, your brim will retain that beautiful curve. I use these forms to give your brim that great curve in the first place, before I send you the hat. I put a thin cloth over the straw I want to iron, set the iron to Wool, and iron the brim. You can do the same to fully restore original brim shape. For brims with curled edges, you will need a special hobby iron.
